

# 2010 PACIFIC COAST *Classic*

## Rules and Qualification Procedures

### Level 9 & Level 10 Individual Qualification to the Pacific Coast Finals

Friday, Feb. 19, 2010

There will be two flights in the Finals competition (Modified Capital Cup format). All Level 10 and Elite gymnasts in this session will be judged according to NCAA gymnastics rules and NCAA FIG scoring which can be downloaded at <http://www.usa-sports.org/PDFgallery.htm>. NCAA Modified FIG and JO Modified FIG are slightly different by comparison.

**\*\* Qualifiers must confirm participation in the Pacific Coast Finals on the awards stand. \*\***

#### The Pacific Coast Finals will consist of the following:

##### Elites

##### Level 9 Jr. Qualifiers from Session 1

##### Level 10 Jr. Qualifiers from Session 2 & 3\*

- Elites (2 squads)
- **Top 6 AA** in Level 9 (Age 12 & younger division)
- **Top 6 AA** in Level 9 (Age 13 division)
- **Top 6** gymnasts on each event Level 9 (Age 12 & younger) after the 6 AA gymnasts in that division are excluded
- **Top 6** gymnasts on each event Level 9 (Age 13) after the 6 AA gymnasts in that division are excluded
- **Top 12 AA** in Level 10 (14-15 division)
- **Top 12 AA** in Level 10 (16-18 division)
- **Top 6** gymnasts on each event Level 10 (14-15) after the 12 AA gymnasts in that division are excluded
- **Top 6** gymnasts on each event Level 10 (16-18) after the 12 AA gymnasts in that division are excluded

#### AWARDS:

- The L10's (Age 14-18) and Elites will compete for top 6 All-Around and Individual Event awards.
- The L9's (Age 12-13) will compete for top 6 All-Around and Individual Event awards.
- Elite Teams will compete against each other for team honors.

**\* NOTE:** Friday's qualifying sessions will award club team and individual awards by session. Qualification to Saturday will be based on the **combined results** of both Level 10 sessions. L10 qualifiers will be announced after Session 3. We will not deviate from this qualification format.
